UC Davis Faculty to Speak about Haiti since the Earthquake

University of California, Davis Medical School professor and physician, Dr. Douglas Gross; Law School professor, Holly Cooper; and 2011-2012 Humprey's Fellow, Hughes Jacques, will speak at UC Davis this Thursday the 26th to commemorate the second anniversary of the earthquake that devastated Haiti in January of 2010.

This anniversary event is the product of a unique collaboration between the northern University of California schools to bring together expert faculty members, professors, and students with the breadth of experience to give a multidisciplinary perspective on the current situation in Haiti. The discussion will raise awareness about the severity, hurdles, and developments of rebuilding since the earthquake, a task that remains almost as large and complex as the day the quake struck. There will be an opportunity for questions and discussion after short presentations by the speakers.
